RULES

PARTICIPATION:

- ▶ Participation will consist of the presentation of a project of dissemination, innovation and/or research in science and/or technology.
- ▶ Each team should consist of 1, 2 or 3 students and 1 supervisor.
- ▶ Registration will be open until October 8, 2023.
- ▶ The official dates of the event are:
Arrivals : December 5
Departures: December 9

Environment (MA)

Any project that is related to:

- The set of physical, chemical, biological, social, economic and cultural components capable of causing direct and indirect effects, in the short or long term on living beings.
- The environment that affects and conditions especially the living circumstances of people or society as a whole.

Keywords: sustainable development, ecology, pollution.

Robotics & Computing (CR)

Any project that is related to:

- The practical application of scientific knowledge to the design and construction of computer programs and the associated documentation required to develop, operate, and maintain them. The development of mobile applications and information management systems for decision making.
- Multidisciplinary projects (mechanics, electronics, computing) that integrate and develop machines or prototypes that benefit the industrial, business and civil sectors with their applications, or in the medical area with the design of prostheses, equipment for the disabled or surgical instruments.
- Developing products involving control systems for the design of intelligent products or processes, which seeks to create more complex machinery to facilitate human activities through electronic processes.

Medicine & Health (MS)

Any project that is related to:

- ▶ Basic medicine (work carried out in the laboratory: sampling, surveys).
- ▶ Clinical medicine (factors associated with diseases, epidemiological studies, public health problems and social impact).
- ▶ Medical sciences such as: anatomy, physiology, physiopathology, biochemistry, microbiology, immunology, internal medicine, surgery, among others.

Key words: prevention, diagnosis, treatment, laboratory, samples, studies, solutions..

- **PAYMENTS:** Monday, November 6, via Bank Transfer.
- **CULTURAL PARTICIPATION, FLIGHT INFORMATION, AND ROOM LIST:** Monday, November 13.



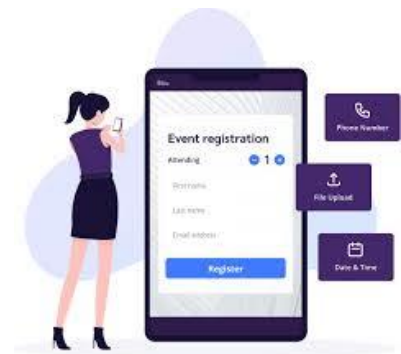
REGISTRATION

The registration of projects, as well as the essential data of students, advisors, and/or companions, will be done through an online form, starting from the issuance of this Call and until Sunday, **October 8, 2023, at 23:59:59 GMT-6.**

The data to prepare the Certificates will be taken from the Registration, so it is essential that the data provided is clear and correct; once the Registration is closed, **there will be no corrections or replacements**





FEE

The participation cost per person depending on the participation status is:

- **Students: 450 USD (From 1 to 3 students per team)**
- **Advisors: 450 USD (Maximum 1 advisor per team)**
- **Companions: 550 USD (Maximum of 3 people per team)**

These costs include:

- Reception at Hermosillo International Airport on December 5, 2023
- Transportation to the hotel
- 4 nights of double occupancy accommodation (check-in on December 5, 2023 - check-out on December 9, 2023)
- Meals:
 - December 5 (Lunch and/or dinner)
 - December 6-7 and 8, 2023 (Breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
 - December 9, 2023 (Breakfast)
- Program activities and visits
- Transfer to Hermosillo International Airport on December 9, 2023
- Participation medal and certificate

Payment must be made by bank transfer no later than Monday, November 6. The account details and payment instructions will be sent to all registered individuals as soon as registration closes.

ADDITIONAL INFO

Once the registration and payments are completed, each delegation will be asked to provide the following information:

- **Flight Itineraries**, considering the official arrival at Hermosillo International Airport on December 5, preferably after 11 am, and the official departure date on December 9.
- **Room List:** We will need to know the arrangement of each delegation in each room, considering that the accommodation will be in double rooms with 2 beds. If any person does not have a companion, they will be assigned one to fill the room capacity, respecting gender, age, and, if possible, language.
- **Cultural Performance by delegation.** Each delegation should define how they will participate in the cultural evening by presenting a dance, song, poetry, etc. National anthems, as well as activities related to armament issues, partisan segregations, and/or political currents, are not allowed.
